REPORT:

The certificates were developed as a result of the MMT Subject Area Committee review of the existing certificate with the intent of developing outcomes as is required for accreditation. Upon review, the faculty came to the conclusion that the existing certificate was simply too generic and that specific outcomes could not be identified. As a result, the SAC developed two new certificates which are highly focused, meet the needs of the industry, and are discernible through specific outcomes unique to each credential. Upon approval by the State Board of Education, it is intended that the original, more generic certificate will be eliminated.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Oregon State Board of Education for two certificates of completion in Machine Manufacturing Technology: CNC Milling and Machine Manufacturing Technology: CNC Turning.
