REPORT: The proposed AAS degree and certificates will allow students to pursue a career in the field of Culinary Arts. This program was developed in response to an industry need in the region in cooperation with local employers. Industry needs were identified that would best provide individuals skills needed to be successful in the workplace or to qualify them for a chef's training program. Outcomes for the program have been designed to align with the national standards of the American Culinary Federation. Individuals will develop proficiency in the operational functions and principles in the foodservice industry that are applicable in the kitchen, bakery, and foodservice venues. The program in Culinary Arts will compliment the existing TBCC program in Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation Management and articulates with existing secondary school programs in the region. The certificates of completion serve as career pathways to the AAS degree.

RECOMMENDATION: That the college be authorized to submit an application to the Oregon State Board of Education for an Associate of Applied Science Degree and two Certificates of Completion: Culinary Arts.
