REPORT:

On November 4, 2008 District residents approved PCC Bond Measure 26-95 authorizing the College to sell up to \$374 Million in general obligation bonds to finance various construction projects.

ORS 255.005 requires the PCC Board, being the District's Election Authority, to review the abstract of votes received from the Multnomah County clerk with respect to Measure 26-95 within 20 days after the date of the election.

In addition, PCC is required to determine the successful passage of the bond measure on November 4, 2008, no later than 30 days after receiving the abstracts from the counties and to notify the Multnomah County clerk of this action.

RECOMMENDATION: That The Board of Directors approve the following:

1. As the "district elections authority" as defined in ORS 255.005, the Board of Directors has reviewed the abstract of votes received from all five County clerks with respect to the November 4, 2008 general obligation bond election (Measure 29-65) within 20 days after the date of the election

 Based on these abstracts, the Board of Directors hereby determines the successful passage of the bond issue on this date which is no later than 30 days after receiving the abstract and authorizes the District President to notify the Multnomah County clerk of this action.
