ACCEPT PROPOSAL/AWARD CONTRACT FOR ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR CASCADE CAMPUS

REPORT:

With passage of the bond measure, the College has the need to contract with a qualified firm to provide comprehensive Architectural Services for the Cascade Campus. Services to be provided include, but may not be limited to the following: Attend Cascade Advisory Committee meetings as requested; Assistance with site location evaluation as requested; Assessment of land use requirements; Programming/schematic design services; Design development; Construction document preparation: Construction administration services; Cost estimating services via in-house or through a consultant; Bidding or negotiation phase services; All other services in connection with a) Public hearings; b) Providing services for change orders and construction change directives; and c) Evaluation of claims, arbitration proceedings, legal proceedings, and all services made necessary by default of contractor in the work.

A Request for Proposals (RFP) for these services was issued and made available to all interested firms on September 1, 2009. The RFP was advertised in the Daily Journal of Commerce, on the State of Oregon Procurement Network (ORPIN), and on the PCC Solicitation website. A total of one-hundred forty four (144) vendors, which included architects; engineers; consultants; plan centers; and other interested parties (forty one (41) of which indicated they were MWESB

firms) registered and downloaded a copy of the RFP document.

A total of nineteen (19) proposals were received in response to the RFP. Written Proposals were reviewed and rated by Bond Program and Cascade Campus evaluation committee members based on the following criteria: Team - firm history and distinctive capabilities; Approach - collaboration and partnering with assigned College staff in an interactive process; Activities - firm's ability to predict project costs develop and meet the project schedule; Other - fee proposal and subcontracting MWESB diversity.

Written proposal evaluation scores by the Bond Team were as follows:

The five (5) highest scoring firms were invited to an oral interview process. Proposers were given six (6) questions to respond to in their presentation. The evaluation team scored each proposer and that score was used to determine the highest rated proposer. The ranking of the oral interview process is as follows:

THA Architecture has identified twelve (12) subconsultants it intends to contract with for this project. Six (6) of the twelve (12) firms are State of Oregon certified MWESB firms.

The Bond Program and Cascade Campus evaluation committee recommends awarding this contract to THA Architecture.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors accept the proposal from, and award the Architectural Services contract for Cascade Campus to THA Architecture. All expenditures for these services will be from bond funds.
