REPORT: Dr. Nan Poppe has served as Campus President –
Extended Learning Campus since June, 2003. Dr. Poppe
will be retiring as of May 1, 2010.

We will start the search process during academic year
2010-11 with a goal of having a permanent Campus
President – Extended Learning Campus selected for the
2011-12 academic year. During the intervening year, it is
essential that leadership and management continuity be
maintained for the Extended Learning Campus and the
communities it serves.

Dr. Craig Kolins, has served PCC as Dean of Instruction
and Student Development for the Extended Learning
Campus since September, 2006. Dr. Kolins previously
served the Rock Creek Campus as Dean of Student
Development from July 2002 – June 2005 and as Interim
Campus President during academic year 2005-06. He also
served as Director, Enrollment Services prior to accepting
his current role at the Extended Learning Campus.

Dr. Kolins received his MS – Education: Counseling from
Northern Illinois University and his Ph.D. Education from
the University of Toledo. He is well versed in the
instructional and student services programs offered by
the Extended Learning Campus as well as the issues and
challenges facing the campus.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board approve the appointment of Dr. Craig Kolins
as the Interim Campus President – Extended Learning
Campus effective May 1, 2010 until such time as the
recruitment and selection process for a permanent Campus
President – Extended Learning Campus can be completed.
