REPORT:

The College has a need for continuous maintenance of the

communication network equipment purchased from

Brocade (formerly known as Foundry Network). On March 20, 2008, Board Resolution 08-064, the Board of Directors

approved the purchase of communication network equipment and maintenance cost through March, 2009. The Technology Solution Services Department (TSS) recommended that it is in the best interest to continue to contract with Brocade for the maintenance of this

equipment to ensure the ongoing operations of the

communication network in the College. The estimated cost will exceed the \$150,000 formal solicitation threshold

requiring Board of Directors approval (B505).

This is exempt from competitive process based on

Community College Rules #208(b, c) concerning ongoing

maintenance of existing equipment. Brocade is considered the only provider for maintenance of the equipment in order to preserve warranties, provide the best possible service and conform to other service

agreements currently in place.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Directors grant expenditure authority for the College to continue the communication network equipment maintenance with Brocade Inc. The estimated maintenance cost for three years is \$615,000.00; this amount will cover an estimated annual payment of \$205,000 for each fiscal year (FY): FY 2009-2010, FY 2010-2011 and FY 2011-12. Funding will be from

General Funds.
