REPORT: At their June 17, 2010 meeting the Board of Directors approved the revised PCC Mission Statement. Board Policy B101 is being revised to reflect the newly revised Mission Statement and PCC's "Who We Are," within the context and philosophy of a comprehensive community college. Staff has reviewed the Mission Statement and "Who We Are," and recommends approval of the attached policy revision (Attachment A) it reflects the newly revised Mission Statement and how PCC functions as a comprehensive community college.

College Mission – B 101
