The College has a potential need to acquire real property adjoining the Southeast Campus, for use in realizing the Board's strategic plan that the Southeast Campus

become fully comprehensive.

This property is owned by AMERCO Real Estate Company, adjoins Southeast on the north side, and is used as the site of a U-Haul storage and rental business.

The College recently completed Phase I and II environmental assessments of this property, which

indicate no significant problems.

The College wishes to negotiate with owners the sale of this property to the College on a voluntary-sale basis.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board delegate authority to the District President or his designee to negotiate the purchase of the above property on a voluntary-sale basis, and to enter into a binding purchase and sale agreement, with the concurrence of College Counsel and the Board Chair. Funds will be provided by the 2008 Bond program.
