REPORT:

The proposed Associate of Applied Science in Landscape Technology: Design prepares individuals for sensoe of employment in the landscape industry. The degree and I will be a south replaces the current two-year certificate in Landscape Design. The Landscape Technology advisory committee and the faculty determined that the students would be better served by the college and better prepared for a leadership position in the industry if they earned an Associate of Applied Science rather than a certificate. A majority of the coursework in the Landscape Technology: Design degree is shared with the existing Associate of Applied Science in Landscape Technology so by state standards it is considered a degree option.

RECOMMENDATION: That the College be authorized to submit an application to the Oregon State Board of Education for an Associate of Applied Science in Landscape Technology: Design for Portland Community College.
