REPORT: The Portland Community College Board Policy B502 states that Portland Community College is committed to providing a safe and healthy work and educational environment for our employees, students and visitors. In support of that policy and in accordance with ORS 634.705, the college needs to implement an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) plan. This needs a proactive strategy that focuses on the long-term prevention or suppression of pest problems, protects the health and safety of students, staff and faculty, protects the integrity of campus buildings and grounds, maintains a productive learning environment, and protects local ecosystems health.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board directs the District President or his designee to develop an IPM plan on or before July 1, 2012 and to designate an IPM officer to start implementing the plan.
