REPORT: On June 26, 2008 the Board of Directors accepted a

proposal and awarded a maximum 5-year contract to Integra Telecom to provide voice, data and video network, incoming and outgoing video, voice and data ISP services to the College. The contract was awarded for three (3) years with an option to renew annually for two (2) additional years. The original contract amount was estimated at \$4,665,506.66 for the entire five (5) year term. Due to the additions of the Willow Creek,

Downtown, Newberg, and Hillsboro Centers that were not part of the original plan when the contract was awarded by the Board (Res. 08-105), the actual expenses for the

first four years expended the funds of the original

contract.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors amend Resolution 08-105 to

allow Technology Solution Services to increase the original contract authority to a maximum of \$7,500,000. Expenditures for this contract are from the General Fund

and Bond Fund.
