ADOPT PORTLAND COMMUNITY COLLEGE STRATEGIC PLAN

REPORT: In October of 2013, PCC President Dr. Jeremy Brown initiated a strategic planning process by sponsoring extensive discussion forums throughout the College, including: ongoing conversations on each campus; meetings with PCC managers, staff, faculty, the external community; website interaction; and dialogue with the Board of Directors to identify strategic issues and opportunities for the College.

The President also formed a 25-member Strategic Planning Steering Committee which was tasked with developing a visionary yet achievable strategic plan to be presented to the President who would then seek final approval by the PCC Board of Directors. This Committee is recognized for its valuable work, important collaborative spirit and intense dedication to completing this plan. The Strategic Plan and its six “themes” and related “strategic intentions” is also a reaffirmation and extension of PCC’s statement of values, critical components of how we will progress.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors approve the proposed PCC Strategic Plan as described in Exhibit E.
