REPORT: The College has created a Title IX team with

representatives across departments/divisions to address issues involving sexual violence, sexual harassment,

domestic violence, dating violence and stalking.

The purpose of the PCC Title IX initiative is to create an environment free from all forms of discrimination based

on sex, gender, gender expression and actual or

perceived gender identity or sexual orientation, gender

identity and sex-based discrimination.

This policy defines community expectations and establishes a mechanism for determining when those

expectations have been violated.

The College strives to create an environment that is safe

for all.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors approve and adopt the

Portland Community College Gender-Based and Sexual Misconduct Policy (Exhibit A) in order to comply with Federal Title IX, the Violence Against Women Act and

Clery Act requirements.
