16-008 AUTHORIZATION TO UTILIZE AN INTER-

GOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE CONTRACT TO PROVIDE ELEVATOR MAINTENANCE, REPAIR AND

MODERNIZATION SERVICES

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REPORT: The College has a need to contract with a qualified company to

provide the college with full elevator maintenance service and

maintain a continuing system of full preventative elevator

maintenance, repair, and modernization services at various PCC

District locations. Staff would like to utilize an existing

intergovernmental cooperative contract (allowable without an additional competitive process per College Procurement Rules,

CCR.205), U.S. Communities, Contract #201414653,

which has a competitively priced contract with Kone, Inc. for providing these services. The estimated cost of these services will exceed the \$150,000 threshold, requiring the Board of Directors

approval (B505).

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors authorize the use of an intergovernmental

contract for the provision of Elevator Maintenance, Repair and Modernization Services and award a four-year contract to Kone, Inc.

in the amount of \$700,000, (based on an annual estimate of \$160,000 except for fiscal year 2016, which is estimated at \$220,000). The contract shall not exceed four (4) years, with a maximum amount of \$700,000. Expenditures for this contract will

come from the general fund and the capital projects fund.
