REPORT: The proposed Multimedia Less Than One-Year Career Pathway

Certificate prepares students for an entry-level position in the film and video industry as production assistant, audio/visual technical assistant, film and video digital assistant, graphic design assistant, or digital media editor. The 20-credit certificate curriculum explores current digital media software used in the industry to design, produce, and deliver digital content for diverse purposes. Students who complete the certificate will be

able to apply a generalized knowledge of media-design principles, human factors, and technology strategies when designing and developing media solutions for clients. All courses in the certificate are embedded in the Multimedia AAS

and One-Year Certificate, providing students a pathway into an entry-level position and an opportunity to continue their

education and career trajectory by acquiring more education.
