

Math Fest 2020



What: Math Fest is a free and fun event hosted by Portland Community College to engage students in mathematics. Middle and high school students can collaborate and compete for prizes and high school students can qualify for the Oregon Invitational Mathematics Tournament (OIMT).

When: Saturday, April 18th from 8:30 am – 12:30 pm. The welcome tables with t-shirts and activities will begin at 8:30 am, with exams beginning at 9:30 am. This year we will have a collaborative team activity after the exams, a team competition and ceremony.

Where: PCC Southeast Campus (2305 SE 82nd Ave Portland, OR 97216)

Who: All high school and middle school students are welcome at the event. Students must be registered in advance to participate in an exam. We request that each school sends a school representative to chaperone students. Parents are also welcome!

Registration: Contact your math teacher or school representative for registration. We offer the following exams that are given statewide: Prealgebra, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Precalculus, and Some Calculus. Students may choose which exam they would like to take. In the months leading up to the event, there will be two rounds in the registration process. We will first request an approximate headcount followed later by a list of student names and exam level for each. Your teacher or school representative will give you the room number on campus to get to before 9:30 am.

Awards: Awards and prizes are given to top scoring students and teams. Both middle and high school students may earn recognition and PCC prizes. High school students who rank in the top 12% on the Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Precalculus, or Some Calculus exams may earn an invitation to the Oregon Invitational Mathematics Tournament (OIMT).
